Meetings and Programs

Are held at Woodcraft , 9862 West Broad Street (Rt. 250), located in the Broad Street Plaza at the corners of Gaskins Rd & West Broad St in Glen Allen, VA.

Lessons

Youth and Adult beginner carving classes are offered through the Woodcraft store and taught by club members. Safety gear is required and a beginners' kit is available through the store.

Programs & Open Carving

Every Thursday at 1:00—4:pm. Open Carving for members. Bring in your own carving project and join us for carving and camaraderie. This is a great time to ask about special carving techniques and tips from some our seasoned woodcarvers. Safety gear is required during all meetings.

First Thursday night of each month at 6:00PM. All members get 10% discount at Woodcraft on program night on all carving supplies. Also, receive a free blank for the night's carving activity.

Show & Tell: At every program meeting, just show up with your latest carving and get a chance to win a \$10 gift card to Woodcraft.

Workshops and Newsletters

Third Saturday of each month from 9:00am to 3:00pm at Woodcraft for members only. Cost is a minimum of \$5 per person nonrefundable to sign-up plus material cost at time of workshop.

Workshops are usually provided by club members who give step by step instruction. Projects vary each month. Be sure to check the website and /or newsletter for exact times and projects.
